

Clery Act Training Quick Resources

Key Points

Any Clery Crime occurring on campus must be reported (to UNTPD or clery.unt.edu) immediately even if the victim/survivor does not want police involvement.

Reports can be made either at clery.unt.edu or by calling UNT PD and having an officer sent to you.

You do not need to investigate any crimes, but we need to know: Who, When, Where, What crime was committed and as detailed of a description of the crime as possible.

Any questions about whether or not a crime is reportable can be directed to UNT PD 24/7/365. Tell dispatch you need to talk to a supervisor about a Clery offense.

Clery Crimes: Murder, Manslaughter, Robbery, Rape, Statutory Rape, Fondling, Incest, Aggravated Assault, Burglary, Arson, Motor Vehicle Theft, Dating Violence, Domestic Violence, Stalking, Hate Crimes.
